WAFA -Women's Project currently has 30 families that have been surveyed and qualified for this project. They have been knitting wool by hand at home since the start of this project, however knitting by hand has proven to be very time consuming and difficult, especially in a home setting. Zara Initiative has come up with a solution that will increase production and improve working conditions.

- Purchasing Sewing Machines that will increase production and income.
- Leasing out a warehouse that will provide a practical working atmosphere and a healthy social environment.
- A Daycare center will be set up, since most of these women have small children that hinder their work at home. The children will also be provided some basic literacy classes.

To get this project started we are in need of funds. For only \$7,180 we will be able to set up this small factory and create the necessary working environment for these women to provide for their families and move towards self-dependence.
